## CERTIFIED CLOGGING INSTRUCTOR TRAINING PROGRAM

### Motivation

Caring, gracious, responsible, direct, dedicated

**Name** actions used by successful leaders

- ◆ Request Instead Of Order
- ◆ Accept Discomfort
- ◆ Establish Goals (But don't expect to reach them all.)
- ◆ Celebrate Success

**Solve** leadership problems

Accept That You Are Not Perfect—Leadership is truly the art of dealing with people who are, by nature, imperfect. You will make mistakes, accept that. Your students will respect you more when they know that you know that you are human, too

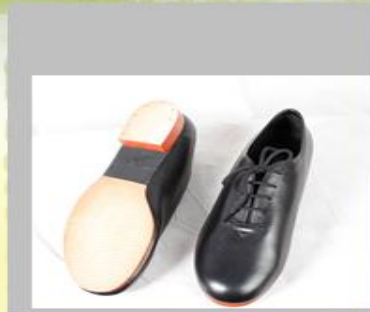

# Fontana...foray into Fall!!

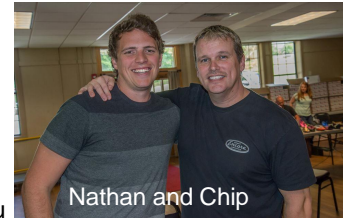

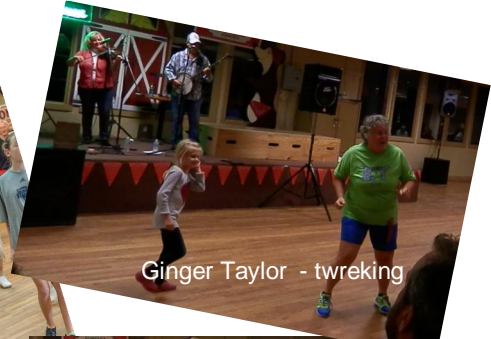

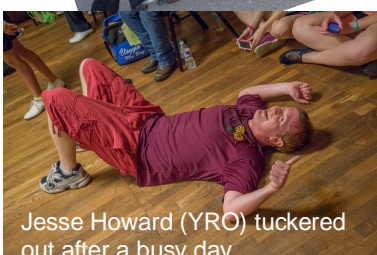
