## Andy Howard finds a great band and a clogging connection in San Antonio!

Here is the story behind his routine to Medicine Man.

"I was asked by the Texas Clogging Council and Buster Green to be the featured instructor at the Great Texas Hoedown in Blanco, Texas, in November 2015. This special workshop highlights the traditional elements of our community, figure dancing, flatfoot, buck footwork, and even line routines to bluegrass and old time music. Buster and Nieci Green made the most of our time to show me highlights of San Antonio and the region. One night, we went to dinner and stopped by Gruene Hall. Built in 1878, Gruene Hall is Texas'



oldest continually operating and most famous dance hall. By design, not much has physically changed since the Hall was first built. The 6,000 square foot dance hall with a high pitched tin roof still has the original layout with side flaps for open air dancing, a bar in the front, a small lighted stage in the back and a huge outdoor garden. Advertisement signs

from the 1930s and 40s still hang in the old hall and around the stage. Buster was excited to show me spots where the dance hall was featured in the movie "Michael", which stars John Travolta as the archangel Michael. We intended to stop by for a moment, but there was a band playing and they were fantastic. The band was called Blue Water Highway Band. The band is named after the roadway spanning the Gulf Coast of Texas and the musicians are classically training with an expansive repertoire. They had one song in particular which was an exciting version of the folk classic John Henry. But, the recorded version was slower tempo than they performed live--perhaps too slow for a solid clogging workshop routine. However, the band's song "Medicine Man" was the one I moved forward with. During a break, Buster, Neici and I talked to the band, purchased merchandise and told them we were cloggers and I was interested in writing a dance to their songs. They were excited, but I'm not sure they ever expected to hear from us again. Well, I choreographed the dance and released it in Nickel City in April 2016. We made a video which

has been shared over 300 times on Facebook. And the band has shared the video through their own networks. Check out the video <a href="here">here</a>. We have had a lot of fun with this routine, and I think the cloggers like the idea of support-

ing up and coming musicians, and especially within the regions of our clogging events and communities. I am currently working on a new routine to a newer song by the band. Stay tuned! "

# Clogging to the top: Knoxville hosts national competition

KNOXVILLE, Tenn. (WVLT) -- There's a different sort of sound emerging from downtown Knoxville this weekend.

It's the stomping, clapping, toe tapping sounds of clogging.

Knoxville is hosting the 19th annual Clogging Champions of America's (CCA) National Showdown.

"This is our largest event of the year," CCA president Lynne Ogle said.

Roughly 650 competitors from as far as California, New York, Nebraska, and even Australia are competing this weekend. The action began Friday morning at the Civic Auditorium. It won't conclude until midnight Saturday night.

"They take this very serious," Ogle explained. "It's their life. They commit to it. It's very serious just like a sport would be at school."

Many at the competition say they interest in clogging began because of family.

"I've been clogging for about two years," Austin Glass said. Austin is just nine years old. "I did it because everybody else in my family clogged."

Eighteen year old Cheyenne Gibson is in town for the event. She's clogged for 12 years. "I enjoy doing it and meeting new people," she said.

"There's a lot of commitment. I'm always having to miss other things, like family events," Gibson continued.

To receive an invitation for this competition, teams and individuals must have won or placed in a regional competition.

The competition features individual dancers and teams from 20 states who will compete in multiple categories. Friday will feature competitive events for individuals and duos. The ages range from 5 to 70 with competition in junior and senior divisions.

Saturday's schedule includes a full day of team dance competitions beginning at 8:15 a.m. and ending at midnight with a final dance-off and awards ceremony. The clogging team routines features between 10

and 15 dancers and often incorporates other genres of dance, including jazz and hip hop.

The Showdown of Champions is open to the public for an admission of \$8 per day.

Formed in 1997, CCA seeks to generate more activity and interest in clogging and to encourage competition and fun in dancers of all skill levels. In addition to the annual showdown, CCA holds approximately 16 additional events throughout the year.

## On the beat.....

## Time to renew!



It is that time of year again! Time to renew those music licenses! Current licenses expire 3/31/2017. Teachers and/or Directors want to be sure you are properly licensed with these music organizations to avoid potential fines that can be in the thousands of dollars. This licensing ensures the music creators **or** the owners of copyrights on musical works are compensated for certain uses of their work. It seems like a small thing, but it is very important for us to respect the property of others so that we can continue to use it.

- WHAT ARE BMI, ASCAP and SESAC? BMI (Broadcast Music, Inc.), ASCAP (American Society of Composers, Authors & Publishers), SESAC, are the licensing organizations which were founded so that the creators of music would be paid for the public performances of their works.
- WHO NEEDS A BMI/ASCAP/SESAC LICENSES? Any user of music who plays copyrighted musical works in public, and
  whose performances are not specifically exempt under the law, needs a license from BMI/ASCAP/SESAC or the
  members whose works the user wishes to perform. As a clogging instructor, licenses are needed from BMI /ASCAP/
  SESAC to cover the music played at your classes, workshops, exhibitions, competitions, and dances throughout the
  year.
- WHY SHOULD I GO THROUGH C.L.O.G. TO GET MY LICENSE? BMI/ASCAP/SESAC negotiate their fees with users who are often represented by national associations, like the National Association of Broadcasters. What better group to represent the needs of cloggers than C.L.O.G. who for over 20 years has worked to serve the needs of instructors and dancers nationwide. By negotiating with BMI/ASCAP/SESAC on behalf of all cloggers nationwide, C.L.O.G. can insure you that licensing rates will be fair and equitable for all cloggers. In addition C.L.O.G. will receive NO COM-MISSION for the licenses purchased by its members.
- HOW DO I GO ABOUT OBTAINING MY LICENSE THROUGH CLOG? By joining the hundreds of cloggers from around the country who are members of this organization you can enjoy the low group rates for BMI/ASCAP/SESAC licenses. The membership fee is \$30.00 per year for the organization. We certainly hope all of you will join and support the organization. We need and welcome your membership. You must be a member of C.L.O.G. to be eligible for licensing by BMI/ASCAP/SESAC at these discounted rates. Simply visit the CLOG website to complete your process.
- IF I HAVE LICENSES WITH ASCAP and/or BMI, WHY DO I NEED A LICENSE WITH SESAC? SES-AC, ASCAP, and BMI are three separate and distinct Performing Rights Organizations (PRO). Each organization represents different songwriters, composers, publishers and copyright holders, and each organization licenses only the copyrighted works of its own respective affiliated copyright holders. Licenses with ASCAP and BMI do NOT grant you authorization for the right to use the copyrighted music of SESAC represented songwriters, composers, publishers or copyright holders.
  - Since a license with ASCAP and/or BMI does not grant authorization to play songs in the SESAC repertory, most businesses obtain licenses with SESAC, ASCAP and BMI to obtain proper copyright clearance for virtually all of the copyrighted music in the world.
